CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert L. Weise, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Commercial (Dairy) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 12, T.14N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 12 bears N. 46°06'20" E., a distance of 1,937.03 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Underground
Manner of Use:	Commercial (Dairy)
Amount of appropriation:	*0.03 c.f.s., but not to exceed 7.10 million gallons annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	October 23, 1990

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 270 feet deep, 8 inch casing, via two submersible pumps, a 5 H.P. and 3 H.P., thence through a distribution system to a commercial dairy with 1,500 Holstein Cows located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 and SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 12, T.14N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M.

*The total combined duty of water under this Certificate and Permit 48628 Certificate 13676 shall not exceed 36.238 million gallons annually.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
