**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Bruce L. Rice, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Commercial and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 3, T.14N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 3 bears S. 65°39'39" W., a distance of 261.05 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Underground
Manner of Use:	Commercial and Domestic
Amount of appropriation:	0.026 c.f.s., but not to exceed 2.80 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	*June 17, 1964

**Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:**


Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 381 feet deep, 8 5/8 inch casing, via two 2 H.P. submersible pumps to a 900 gallon pressure tank, thence through a distribution system to a restaurant and nursery for commercial purposes located within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 3, T.14N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M.

\*This certificate changes the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of Permit 50520, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 45858, which changed the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of Permit 22060, Certificate 6119, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 22060, Certificate 6119.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
