CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J.R. Hildebrand, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump, and distribution system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¼ SE¼ Section 6, T.16N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 6 bears S. 86°00'00" W., a distance of 3,300.0 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

 Manner of Use: Irrigation and Domestic
 Amount of appropriation: *0.0394 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.96 acre-feet annually
 Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year

*The water under this certificate and any certificate issued under Permit 53595 is comingled and the total combined rate of diversion and duty of water shall not exceed 0.2754 c.f.s. and 47.20 acre-feet annually for the irrigation of 11.80 acres total.


**This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 25495, Certificate 8225, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 25495, Certificate 8225.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
