CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Carl Ruschmeyer, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (North Clapham Well #1) through a drilled well, pump, and distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ NE¼ Section 33, T.14N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.,  
or at a point from which the N¼ corner of said  
Section 33 bears N. 68°38'00" W., a distance of  
2,676.0 feet situated in Douglas County, State  
of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Douglas County  
Source: Underground (North Clapham Well #1)  
Manner of Use: Quasi-Municipal  
Amount of appropriation: 0.236 c.f.s., but not to exceed  
13.87 million gallons annually  
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st  
of each year  
Date of priority of  
appropriation: \*October 8, 1975

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 220 feet deep, 12 inch casing, via a pump equipped with a 75 H.P. electric motor, thence through a distribution system which has a 606,000 gallon storage tank, to a residential area located within the NW¼, W¼ SW¼ Section 1; all of Sections 2, 3, and 4; NE¼, E¼ NW¼ Section 10; N¼ Section 11; W¼ NW¼ Section 12; T.13N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., SE¼, S¼ NE¼ Section 20; S¼, S¼ NW¼, SW¼ NE¼ Section 21; SW¼ SW¼ Section 22; E¼ Section 29; all of Sections 26, 27, 28, 33, 34 and 35; E¼ Section 32; W¼ Section 36, T.14N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.


\*This certificate changes the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of Permit 52707, which changed the place of use of Permit 51840, which changed the manner of use and place of use of Permit 29697, Certificate 10418, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 29697, Certificate 10418.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
