CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Paul Lumos, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Well #5) through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 20, T.12N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 20 bears N. 89°38'00" E., a distance of 1,300.45 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Gardnerville Ranchos General Improvement District
Source: Underground (Well #5)
Manner of Use: Quasi-Municipal
Amount of appropriation: 0.411 c.f.s., but not to exceed 9.66 million gallons annually
Period of use: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: **June 28, 1966

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 450 feet deep, 16 inch casing, via a 6 stage vertical turbine pump equipped with a 150 H.P. General Electric motor, thence through a distribution system to the place of use located within portions of the E 1/2 SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 8; S 1/2 SE 1/4, SW 1/4 NE 1/4, S 1/2, S 1/2 NW 1/4 Section 10; SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 14; W 1/2, W 1/2 E 1/2, E 1/2 NE 1/4 Section 15; W 1/2 NW 1/4, E 1/2 W 1/2, E 1/2 Section 16; E 1/2 NE 1/4 Section 17; NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 20; E 1/2, NE 1/4 NW 1/4, NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 21; Section 22; SW 1/4 NW 1/4, NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 23; NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 27; E 1/2 NE 1/4 Section 28; all in T.12N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.

*The total combined duty of water under this certificate and Permit 48750, Certificate 12756; Permit 48761, Certificate 12796; Permit 55360, Certificate 14383; Permit 55420, Certificate 14384, and any certificates issued under Permits 48749, 48752, 48754, 48757, 48759, 55358, 55359, 55381, 55382, 60098, 60099, 60100, 60887, 61731, 61732, 61733, 61734, 61735, 62004, 62005 and 62006 shall not exceed 1,580.95 million gallons annually.

*The total combined rate of diversion under this certificate and Permit 48761, Certificate 12796; Permit 55360, Certificate 14383; and Permit 55359, Certificate 15073; is limited to 2.89 c.f.s.


**This certificate changes the point of diversion, place of use and manner of use of a portion of Permit 53264, which changed the place of use of Permit 23204, Certificate 7278, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 23204, Certificate 7278.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
