CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, James A. Gibbons, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from the Truckee River via Steamboat Canal for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ SW¼ Section 31, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M.,
or at a point from which the SE corner of said
Section 31 bears S. 62°04' E., a distance of
3,195.0 feet situated in Washoe County, State of
Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: James A. and Theresa Dawn Gibbons
Source: Truckee River
Manner of Use: Irrigation
Amount of appropriation: 0.0091 c.f.s., but not to exceed
3.0 acre-feet per season as decreed
Period of use: As Decreed
Date of priority of appropriation: *December 22, 1874

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:


0.67 acres in the SW¼ NE¼ of Section 02, T.18N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Claim 153, Truckee River Final Decree, in United States v. Orr Water Ditch Co., In Equity Docket No. A-3 (D. Nevada 1944), therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Claim 153.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
