CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Richard W. Arden, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from the Truckee River via the Last Chance Ditch for as decreed purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

Last Chance Ditch

SE¼ NE¼ Section 14, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 14 bears N. 24°26' E., a distance of 1,840.0 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: John Flanigan
Source: Truckee River via Last Chance Ditch
Manner of Use: As Decreed
Amount of appropriation: 0.132 c.f.s., but not to exceed 41.2 acre-feet per season as decreed
Period of use: As Decreed
Date of priority of appropriation: *January 13, 1878

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:


10.3 acres in the SE¼ NW¼ of Section 12, T.18N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion of a portion of Claim 72, Truckee River Final Decree, in United States v. Orr Water Ditch Co., In Equity Docket No. A-3 (D. Nevada 1944), therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Claim 72.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
