CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

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WHEREAS, Carl Ruschmeyer, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Sierra Shadows Well #1), through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW¹/₄ NW¹/₄ Section 10, T.13N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 10 bears N. 05°11'20" W., a distance of 2,515.32 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Underground (Sierra Shadows Well #1)
Manner of Use:	Quasi-Municipal
Amount of appropriation:	*0.04 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.023 million gallons annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	**October 8, 1974

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 175 feet deep, with a 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 7½ H.P. submersible pump, thence through a distribution system including 664,000 and 410,000 gallon storage tanks serving approximately 195 residential and commercial units within the Genoa Water System Service Area as described:

NW¹/₄ Section 1; N¹/₂, SW¹/₄, portion of the NW¹/₄ SE¹/₄ Section 2; E¹/₂, portion of the W¹/₂ Section 3; portion of the E¹/₂ NE¹/₄, portion of the SE¹/₄ Section 4; portion of the E¹/₂ Section 9; NW¹/₄, portion of the NE¹/₄, portion of the SW¹/₄, portion of the NW¹/₄ SE¹/₄ Section 10; SW¹/₄ SE¹/₄ Section 15; portion of the NE¹/₄ NE¹/₄ Section 16; NW¹/₄ NE¹/₄ Section 22; all within T.13N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M. SE¹/₄ Section 22; portion of the SW¹/₄ Section 25; Section 26; NE¹/₄, portion of the NW¹/₄, S¹/₂ Section 27; NE¹/₄ SE¹/₄ Section 28; portion of the NW¹/₄, NE¹/₄, portion of the SE¹/₄, portion of the SE¹/₄ SW¹/₄ Section 34; Section 35; all within T.14N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M.

*The total combined diversion rate of water under this certificate and Permits 42384, Certificate 14208; 42385, Certificate 14209; 52731, Certificate 14213; 64095, Certificate 16441; and 66342, Certificate 16442; shall not exceed 0.145 c.f.s.

The total combined duty of water under this certificate and Permit 42384, Certificate 14208; 42385, Certificate 14209; 52731, Certificate 14213; 64095, Certificate 16441; and 66342, Certificate 16442; shall not exceed 10.503 million gallons annually

**This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 42383, which changed the place of use and manner of use of Permit 28786, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 28786.


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This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
