CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Margo Garms, Permittee, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 5, T.16N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 5 bears S. 55°58'41" W., a distance of 530.69 feet, situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Source:	Underground
Manner of Use:	Irrigation
Amount of appropriation:	0.0188 c.f.s., but not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	*May 27, 1977

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well 200 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 3 H.P. Franklin motor and 3 H.P. Starite submersible pump, thence through a distribution system for sprinkler and drip irrigation of 1 acre of pasture and associated landscaping, located within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 5, T.16N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. being further described as Assessor's Parcel Number 050-304-20, Washoe County, Nevada.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion, place of use and manner use of a portion of Permit 50993, Certificate 12509, which changed the point of diversion, place of use and manner use of a portion of Permit 48447, which changed the point of diversion and manner use of a portion of Permit 31848, therefore the date of priority remains the same as Permit 31848.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre annually from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
