CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Karen Brigg, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Truckee River (via Steamboat Canal), through a diversion pipe, ditch, spillway and reservoir (Lake Stanley, aka Wheeler Reservoir) for recreation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

Steamboat Canal

NE¼ SW¼ Section 31, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 31, bears S. 62°04'00" E., a distance of 3,195.0 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Lake-Ridge Shores
Source: Truckee River (via Steamboat Canal)
Manner of Use: Recreation and Domestic
Amount of appropriation: 1.25 c.f.s., but not to exceed 409.64 acre-feet as decreed
Period of use: as decreed
Date of priority of appropriation: *January 1878

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from the Truckee River via Steamboat Ditch through a section of steel pipe, 8-inches in diameter, equipped with a lockable gate valve, thence down a spillway to Lake Stanley for recreation and domestic purposes, located within the SW¼ SW¼ Section 26 and the NW¼ Section 35, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M.

*This certificate changes the place of use and manner of use of a portion of Claim 65 Truckee River Final Decree, in United States v. Orr Water Ditch Co., In Equity Docket No. A-3 (D. Nevada 1944), therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Claim 65.

This certificate corrects the Permitted duty to reflect title being confirmed for the total quantity of water requested in the original application.

This certificate is issued subject to continuing jurisdiction and regulation by the Federal Water Master.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
