CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Suzan L. Ferguson, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use from the Truckee River through Last Chance Ditch for as decreed purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

Last Chance Ditch

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 14, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 13, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., bears N. 24°26' E., a distance of 1,840.0 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the **place where such water is appurtenant**, as follows:

Source: **Truckee River**

Manner of use: **As Decreed**

Amount of appropriation: **0.031 c.f.s., but not to exceed 7.56
acre-feet as decreed**

Period of use: **As Decreed**

Date of priority of appropriation: ***January 14, 1878**

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from the Truckee River via Last Chance Ditch, thence pumped through a distribution system for flood and sprinkler irrigation of 1.89 acres of pasture and associated landscaping located within portions of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 20 and the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 21, all in T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as within a portion of Assessor's Parcel Number 009-131-49, Washoe County, Nevada.

This certificate amends the Place of Use of Permit 64462 as within T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion of a portion of Claim 54, Truckee River Final Decree, United States v. Orr Water Ditch Co., In Equity Docket No. A-3 (D. Nevada 1944), therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Claim 54.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and specifically subject to the continuing jurisdiction and regulation by the Federal Water Master.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
