

STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Gregory M. Bilyeu, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 5, T.16N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 5 bears S. 34°35'50" E., a distance of 1,775 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Manner of use:	Irrigation
Amount of appropriation:	0.0251 c.f.s., but not to exceed 5.0 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	*May 27, 1977

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 180 feet deep, 6-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 3 H.P. Berkeley submersible pump and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for sprinkler irrigation of 1.302 acres of pasture located within a portion of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 5, T.16N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as within a portion of Assessor's Parcel Number 050-303-15, Washoe County, Nevada.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion Permit 50992, Certificate 12508, which changed the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of Permit 48447, which changed the point of diversion and manner of use of a portion of Permit 31848; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 31848.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 3.841 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated annually from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
