CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Rick P. Christian, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW¹/₄ SW¹/₄ Section 8, T.17N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 8 bears S. 26°16'27" W., a distance of 2,643.07 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation:	0.033 c.f.s., but not to exceed 12.0 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st through December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	*April 20, 1972

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 275 feet deep, 6-inch diameter casing, equipped with a Sta-Rite submersible pump and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system including a 24,000-gallon concrete storage tank for flood and sprinkler irrigation of 2.3 acres of alfalfa and 0.7 acres of prairie grass and sunflowers located within a portion of the NW¹/₄ SW¹/₄ Section 8, T.17N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as within a portion of Assessor's Parcel Number 015-355-30, Lyon County, Nevada.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 72763, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 42898, Certificate 12769; which changed the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 31040, Certificate 9187; which changed the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 30168, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 27817, which changed the point of diversion of Permit 26675; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 26675.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total annual duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
