CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Michelle Van Sickle, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for commercial and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¹/₄ SW¹/₄ Section 2, T.10N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W¹/₄ corner of said Section 2 bears N. 80°00'00" W., a distance of 1,891.36 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Manner of use:	Commercial and Domestic
Amount of appropriation:	*0.0021 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1.48 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st through December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	**January 7, 1948

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 200 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 3.0 H.P. submersible pump, four pressure tanks and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for commercial and domestic water service to Wellington Station Resort for 12 mobile homes, 18 RV spaces, one cabin, two restrooms and associated landscaping located within portions of the SW¹/₄ NW¹/₄, SE¹/₄ NW¹/₄, NW¹/₄ SW¹/₄, NE¹/₄ SW¹/₄, and SW¹/₄ SW¹/₄ Section 2, T.10N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as Assessor's Parcel Number 010-631-20, Lyon County, Nevada.


*The total combined duty of water under Permit 60037, Certificate 15010; Permit 62128, Certificate 19025 and Permit 76039 shall not exceed 15.07 acre feet annually.

**This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of Permit 12156, Certificate 3397, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 12156, Certificate 3397.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
