

**STATE OF NEVADA****CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

**WHEREAS**, Patricia Fietta, Permittee, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

**SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 10, T.11N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of said Section 10 bears S. 85°17'08" W., a distance of 136.81 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.**

**Under the provisions of NRS 533.425**, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

**Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 298 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 50 H.P. U.S. motor, Fairbanks Morse pump and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for wheel-line sprinkler irrigation of 33.3 acres of pasture grass and hay located within a portion of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 10, T.11N., R.25E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as within a portion of Assessor's Parcel Number 012-401-17, Lyon County, Nevada.**

\*This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 28042, Certificate 9855; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 28042, Certificate 9855.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit with the understanding that the total seasonal duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
