CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Dennis DeLange, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 27, T.13N., R.20E., M.D.B.& M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 34 T.13N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M. bears S. 19°23'24" W., a distance of 7,359.0 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Manner of use:	Quasi-Municipal
Amount of appropriation:	*0.002 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.5 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1 st through December 31 st of each year
Date of priority of Appropriation:	**August 26, 1980

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 300 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with 7.5 H.P. Franklin submersible pump and totalizing meter, thence to the Bently Science park HVAC cooling towers located within portions of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 27, T.13N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.

*The total combined duty of water under Permit 51330, Certificate 16076; Permit 53869 and Permit 65222, Certificate 19347 shall not exceed 70.02 acre-feet annually.


**This certificate changes the point of diversion of a portion of Permit 51330, which changed the manner of use of

Permit 42193, Certificate 10838; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 42193, Certificate 10838.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
