

STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Carl Ruschmeyer, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well (Heybourne Well), pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 32, T.14N., R.20E., M.D.B.& M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 32 bears N. 32°11'32" E., a distance of 4,640.30 feet situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator:	Douglas County
Source:	Underground (Heybourne Well)
Manner of use:	Quasi-Municipal and Domestic
Amount of appropriation:	0.2235 c.f.s., but not to exceed 38.64 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st through December 31st of each year
Date of priority of Appropriation:	*October 8, 1975

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:


Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 446 feet deep, 16-inch diameter casing, equipped with J. Line pump, Franklin motor and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system including storage tanks to Douglas County's East Valley Water System's water customers within the place of use approved under the permit as depicted by record (map and legal description), which is filed in the Office of the State Engineer, otherwise known as the Douglas County East Valley Water System as it existed at the time of filing of Application 64196.

***This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Permit 59611, which changed the point of diversion and the place of use of a portion of Permit 56857, which changed the place of use of a portion of Permit 52707, which changed place of use of Permit 51840, which changed the manner and place of use of Permit 29697, Certificate 10418; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as permit 29697, Certificate 10418.**

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
