

STATE OF NEVADA**CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Cary Yamamoto, Agent, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source, through a drilled well (North Well), pump and distribution system for commercial (turf sod cultivation) purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 17, T.17N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 17 bears S. 4°30' W., a distance of 2,520.0 feet situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation:	*0.05525 c.f.s., but not to exceed 40.0 acre-feet annually
Period of use:	January 1st through December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation:	**May 28, 1970

Description of the works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 316 feet deep, 8-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 100 H.P U.S. motor, pump and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for commercial impact sprinkler cultivation of turf sod at the Dayton Valley Turf Farm, located within portions of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ (lying south of the U.S. Highway 50 right of way), NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ (being the westerly 19.36 acres), SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ (being the westerly 4.0 acres), all of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 17, and a portion of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ (lying south of the U.S. Highway 50 right of way) and all of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 18; all in T.17N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M.

*The total amount of water that may be diverted from this well for commercial turf sod cultivation under Permit 78701, Certificate 19508; Permit 78977, Permit 78981 and Permit 83587 shall not exceed 204.75 acre-feet annually.


*The water under Permits 78697, Certificate 19491; 78701, Certificate 19508; 78703, Certificate 19509; Permits 78977, 78979, 78981, Permit 82297, Certificate 19511 and Permit 83587 is commingled, and the total combined duty shall not exceed 246.02 acre-feet annually for commercial turf sod cultivation within the above-described place of use.

**This certificate changes the point of diversion, manner and place of use of a portion of Permit 62517, which changed the point of diversion and place of use of Permit 56453, which changed the place of use of a portion of Permit 25640; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 25640.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
