CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined:

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

Steamboat Canal

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 31, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 31 bears S. 62°04' E., a distance of 3,195.0 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Owner of record: **Robert E. Mays, Jr. Family Trust Agreement**

Source: **Truckee River**

Manner of use: **As Decreed**

Amount of appropriation: **0.0116 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.86 acre-feet as decreed**

Period of use: **As Decreed**

Date of priority: **December 20, 1871***

Description of the works of diversion and the manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from the Truckee River through the Steamboat Canal, headgate, ditches and ponds for sprinkler and flood irrigation of 0.215 acres of landscaping and ponds located within a portion of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 18, T.18N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M., being further described as a portion of Assessor's Parcel Number 044-020-47, Washoe County, Nevada.


This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and specifically subject to the following terms:

The total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre as decreed from all sources and this certificate is issued subject to the continuing jurisdiction and regulation by the Federal Water Master and the State Engineer.

***This certificate changes the point of diversion and place of use of a portion of Claim 356, Truckee River Final Decree, in United States v. Orr Water Ditch Co., In Equity Docket No. A-3 (D. Nevada 1944); therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Claim 356.**

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
