

**STATE OF NEVADA****CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined:

The points of diversion of water from the source are as follows:

- (1) **Steamboat Canal (Hunter Creek Reservoir):** Located within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 31, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M.
- (2) **Highland Ditch (Highland Reservoir):** Located within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 9, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M.
- (3) **Idlewild Treatment Plant:** Located within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 10, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M.
- (4) **North Truckee Ditch (Glendale Treatment Plant):** Located within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 7, T.19N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.
- (5) **Orr Ditch (Chalk Bluff Treatment Plant):** Located within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 17, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M.
- (6) **Orr Ditch Pump Station (Chalk Bluff Treatment Plant):** Located within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 17, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M.

Description of the works of diversion and the manner and place of use:

**Water is diverted from the Truckee River via Steamboat Canal, Highland Ditch, Idlewild Treatment Plant, North Truckee Ditch, Orr Ditch and Orr Ditch Pump Station, thence the water is treated and pumped into Truckee Meadows Water Authority's water distribution system. The overall system ultimately conveys the treated water to Truckee Meadows Water Authority's water customers within its certified water service area as depicted by record (map and legal**

description), which is filed in the Office of the State Engineer.


This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and specifically subject to the following terms:

This certificate is issued subject to the continuing jurisdiction and regulation by the Federal Water Master and the State Engineer.

\*This certificate changes the point of diversion, place and manner of use of a portion of Permit 11489, Certificate 4827, which changed the point of diversion of Claim 259. In addition, this certificate changes the point of diversion, place and manner of use of portions of Claims 179.5/206 and 221/222, Truckee River Final Decree, United States v. Orr Water Ditch Co., In Equity Docket No. A-3 (D. Nevada 1944); therefore, the dates of priority remain the same as Claims 179.5/206/259 and 221/222.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
