CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

Under the provisions of NRS 533.425, the State Engineer has determined:

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows:

NE¼ NE¼ Section 22, T.20S., R.52E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 22 bears N. 19°15' 15" E., a distance of 776 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Owner of record: Harris Ltd.
 Source: Underground
 Manner of use: Irrigation
 Amount of appropriation: 0.03 c.f.s., but not to exceed 12.0 acre-feet annually
 Period of use: January 1st through December 31st of each year
 Date of priority: June 22, 1955*

Description of the works of diversion and the manner and place of use:

Water is developed by means of a drilled well, 240 feet deep, 6-inch diameter casing, equipped with a 10 H.P. Wolf pump and totalizing meter, thence through a distribution system for sprinkler irrigation of 2.4 acres of pasture grass located within a portion of the NE¼ NE¼ Section 22, T.20S., R.52E., M.D.B.&M.


This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and specifically subject to the following terms:

The total annual duty of water shall not exceed 5.0 acre-feet per acre of land irrigated from all sources.

***This certificate changes a portion of Permit 72214, which changed a portion of Permit 45873, Certificate 12856, which changed Permit 34681, which changed a portion of Permit 16570, Certificate 5504; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 16570, Certificate 5504.**

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
