CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, George Hellerich, Manager, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from An underground source (Fish Creek Well No. 2) through pipeline and trough for stockwatering and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 13, Township 15 N., Range 52 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed, or at a point from which the S.W. Corner of Township 16 N., Range 53 E., M.D.B. & M., bears N. 15° 02' E., 11,192 feet, situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Bartholomae Oil Corporation
Post-office address: Eureka, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.011 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 350 cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: December 24, 1942

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-
Water developed by means of a drilled well 376 feet deep cased with 375 feet of 8 inch casing. Well equipped with Jensen pump jack and 2 H.P. air cooled engine. Water is pumped through 50 feet of 2 inch pipe to a 10,000 gallon steel tank, thence through 100 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe to 80 feet of steel troughs. Place of use is in the said unsurveyed NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 13, Township 15 N., Range 52 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
