CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Natalie F. and H. D. Cornell has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground Source (Well No. 25 Pahrump Artesian Basin)

through ditches for Irrigation purposes.

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: In the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 3, T. 21 S., R. 54 E., M.D.M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Section 3 bears S. 2° 54' W., 1318.0 feet.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

(1) Lands under this certificate are supplemented in part by Permit No. 10472. The total duty of water per acre for the year is not to exceed 7.2 Acre-feet.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
