CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John Sutherland has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source
(Artesian Well)

through pump, tank and pipeline for
Irrigation and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 23, T. 17 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/2 Corner of said Section 23, bears S. 39° 36' 41" E. 566.28 feet.
situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 46, Statutes of 1937 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.035 c.f.s. or 25.36 acre feet per annum.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation August 1, 1946


Description of land to be irrigated:

3.5 acres in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 23, T. 17 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M.

Note: An artesian cased well, 97 feet deep, equipped with a 3 H.P.

electric pump that pumps the water into a 225 gallon pressure tank.

Water conveyed to places of use by 3/4" pipeline.



The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
