CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, A. J. Evans, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 25, T. 38N., R. 38E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point from which the E 1/2 corner of said Section 25 bears S. 65° 48' 10" E., a distance of 2,992 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 5.392 c.f.s., not to exceed 3903.65 ac-ft per annum
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
* Date of priority of appropriation February 11, 1971

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant: See Attached Tabulation

* This certificate changes the place of use of Permit 25957, Certificate 9115; therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 25957, Certificate 9115.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any and/or all sources.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
