WHEREAS, the records of the Nye County Assessor's Office state that Bolling Enterprises is the owner of the parcel of land as described by Nye County Assessor's Parcel No. 35-31-103, which is within the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 15, T.20S., R.53E., M.D.B.&M., of the Pahrump Valley; and

WHEREAS, the records of the Nevada Division of Water Resources show that Proof No. 02400 was filed on March 28, 1955 by and for J.M. Raycraft. Proof No. 02400 was filed for the purpose of irrigating approximately 120 acres of land from an underground source; and

WHEREAS, a field investigation was conducted on January 20, 1994, by staff of the Southern Nevada Branch Office of the Nevada Division of Water Resources, which indicates that the discharge line from the well leading to the land to be irrigated has been disconnected and that the well is now being used for a batch plant/gravel processing operation; and

WHEREAS, Nevada Revised Statutes 533.325 states, "Any person who wishes to appropriate any of the public waters, or to change the place of diversion, manner of use or place of use of water already appropriated, shall, before performing any work in connection with such appropriation, change in place of diversion or change in manner or place of use, apply to the state engineer for a permit to do so"; and

WHEREAS, the records of the Nevada Division of Water Resources do not reflect that an application is on file or that there is an existing water right for any use other than irrigation from said well or at the place of use of the batch plant; and

WHEREAS, the location of the well is within the jurisdiction of various orders issued by the State Engineer, including Order No. 176, dated March 11, 1941; Order No. 205, dated January 23, 1953; Order No. 381, dated June 1, 1970; and Order No. 955, dated October 26, 1987.

NOW THEREFORE, YOU ARE HEREBY ORDERED to cease and desist immediately the use of water from this well.
