WHEREAS, in accordance with the final decree in the adjudication of the waters of Barber Creek, distribution of the waters of Barber Creek is under the jurisdiction of the State Engineer.

WHEREAS, the records of the Douglas County Recorder's Office indicate the following are the owners of record of the parcels of land listed below: Jack Crawford, APN 19-191-01; Robert and Luella Watrous, Trustees, APN 19-191-02 and APN 19-191-27; Eric and Debbie Gignoux, APN 19-191-05 and APN 19-191-26; John Dugan and Dena Jensen, APN 19-191-07; Andrew Hughes, APN 19-191-08; Willis and Minnie Ward, APN 19-191-09; Shawn Hall and Rozanne Schade, APN 19-191-10; Betty Keller, APN 19-191-21; Stanley Guldin, APN 19-191-22; and Gail Maynard, APN 20-200-07; and all are located either within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ or the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, T.13N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M.

WHEREAS, field investigations were conducted on April 19, 1995, and on August 19, 1996, by staff of the Nevada Division of Water Resources. Said investigations found that water is being diverted from Barber Creek by means of multiple two inch diameter pipelines and is being used for irrigation purposes on Assessor's Parcels 19-191-01, 19-191-02, 19-191-27, 19-191-05, 19-191-26, 19-191-07, 19-191-08, 19-191-09, 19-191-22 and 20-200-07.

WHEREAS, the records of the Division of Water Resources indicate there are no permitted, vested or decreed water rights for use of the waters of Barber Creek on any of the lands located within the W $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, T.13N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., including all of the assessor's parcels identified above.

WHEREAS, Nevada Revised Statute 533.325 states that "Any person who wishes to appropriate any of the public waters, or to change the place of diversion, manner of use or the place of use of water already appropriated, shall, before performing any work in connection with such appropriation, change in place of diversion or place of use, apply to the state engineer for a permit to do so".

WHEREAS, no applications to change water already appropriated from Barber Creek have been filed and no permit issued by the State Engineer for use of Barber Creek water on Douglas County Assessor's Parcels 19-191-01, 19-191-02, 19-191-27, 19-191-05, 19-191-26, 19-191-07, 19-191-08, 19-191-09, 19-191-22 and 20-200-07.

WHEREAS, the records in the office of the State Engineer indicate that the owners of the above numbered parcels were informed that their present diversions are illegal and change applications are required; and the owners have failed to comply with the law by filing change applications and appropriate title documents.

NOW THEREFORE, YOU, AND ALL OF YOU, ARE HEREBY ORDERED to cease and desist immediately the diversion and use of the waters of Barber Creek on the above numbered parcels located in Carson Valley, Douglas County, Nevada.
