**FOR DOMESTIC WELL CREDIT IN THE
CHURCHILL VALLEY HYDROGRAPHIC BASIN**

WHEREAS, this order is adopted under the procedure set forth in Chapter 534.350 of the Nevada Revised Statutes for the establishment of a program that allows a public water system to receive credits for the addition of new customers to its system.

WHEREAS, this order is within the Silver Springs portion of the Churchill Valley Hydrographic Basin (102) designated under State Engineer's Order No. 689, August 23, 1977.

WHEREAS, this order amends State Engineer's Order No. 1181, for domestic well credit, for the purpose of adding nine (9) additional parcels more specifically described by Lyon County Assessor Parcel Number (APN) as being:



The APNs are located within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 35, T.18N., R.24E., M.D.B.&M., within the Churchill Valley Hydrographic Basin, Lyon County, Nevada.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority in NRS 534.350, the State Engineer hereby amends the domestic well credit program as described in State Engineer's Order No. 1181, for a public water system to receive credits for new customers who are now served by domestic wells or who could drill a domestic well on a lot created prior to July 1, 1993, to include the above-mentioned parcels of land.
