

GRANTING PETITION FOR

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

On September 2, 2010, TEC Civil Engineering Consultants, acting as agents on behalf of Big Spring Ranch, LLC and the Star Living Trust petitioned the State Engineer for the adjudication of water rights of Johnson Springs (aka Big Springs). The State Engineer, after due consideration and investigation, has decided that facts and conditions warrant the initiation of proceedings for Determination of the Relative Rights in and to all Waters of Big Springs, a.k.a. Johnson Springs, and Johnson Creek, a.k.a. Hardy Creek, and their respective tributaries and other unnamed springs located within the area of influence of Big Springs and Johnson Creek within the Goshute Valley (Hydrographic Basin No. 10-187) located in Elko County, Nevada.

By virtue of authority granted him in NRS 533.090, the State Engineer enters this ORDER to proceed with the determination in question.
