ORDER

**DESIGNATING AND DESCRIBING THE CLAYTON VALLEY
HYDROGRAPHIC BASIN (10-143)
WITHIN ESMERALDA COUNTY, NEVADA**

The State Engineer finds that conditions warrant the designation of the Clayton Valley Hydrographic Basin 10-143, located within Esmeralda County, Nevada, and by this Order, pursuant to Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) § 534.030, designates the following described areas of land in need of additional administration.

T.2N., R.40E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian (M.D.B.&M.)

All of Section 35 and those portions of Sections 22, 25, 26, 27, 34, and 36 within the Clayton Valley drainage basin.

T.2N., R.41E., M.D.B.&M.

That portion of Section 31 within the Clayton Valley drainage basin.

T.1N., R.38½E., M.D.B.&M.

Those portions of Sections 28, 31, 32, and 33 within the Clayton Valley drainage basin.

T.1N., R.39E., M.D.B.&M.

All of Sections 25, 29, and 31 through 36 and those portions of Sections 19 through 24, 26, 27, 28, and 30 within the Clayton Valley drainage basin.

All of Sections 1, 2, 11, 13, 14, 15, 22, 23, and 26 through 34 and those portions of Sections 3, 9, 10, 12, 16, 19, 20, 21, 24, 25, 35, and 36 within the Clayton Valley drainage basin.

T.5S., R.38E., M.D.B.&M.

Those portions of Sections 1, 2, 3, and 12 within the Clayton Valley drainage basin.

T.5S., R.39E., M.D.B.&M.

All of Sections 1 through 5 and 12 and those portions of Sections 6 through 11, 13, and 14 within the Clayton Valley drainage basin.

T.5S., R.40E., M.D.B.&M.

All of Sections 4 through 9, 16, 17, 20, 21, and 29 and those portions of Sections 1, 2, 3, 10, 15, 18, 19, 22, 23, 26, 27, 28, 30, 31, 32, 33, and 34 within the Clayton Valley drainage basin.

The designated Clayton Valley Hydrographic Basin is depicted and defined on Nevada Division of Water Resources, State Engineer's Office maps.

As required under NRS § 534.030, a public hearing in the matter of the designation of Clayton Valley Hydrographic Basin was held in Silver Peak, Nevada, on February 11, 2016. Based on information received at the hearing and other data and information available to the State Engineer, it is determined that this groundwater basin is in need of additional administration under the provisions of NRS Chapter 534.
