ORDER

**DESIGNATING AND DESCRIBING THE BUFFALO VALLEY
HYDROGRAPHIC BASIN (10-131) WITHIN HUMBOLDT,
LANDER AND PERSHING COUNTIES, NEVADA**

The State Engineer finds that conditions warrant the designation of the Buffalo Valley Hydrographic Basin, 10-131, located within Humboldt, Lander, and Pershing Counties, Nevada, and by this Order, pursuant to Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) § 534.030, designates the following described areas of land in need of additional administration.

T.27N., R.41E., Mount Diablo Base and Meridian (M.D.B.&M.)

All of Sections 3 and 4 and those portions of Sections 1, 2, 5, 8, 9, 10, 11, 16 and 17 within the Buffalo Valley drainage basin.

T.28N., R.40E., M.D.B.&M.

All of Sections 1, 2, 3, 12 and 13 and those portions of Sections 4, 5, 6, 8, 9, 10, 11, 14, 23, 24 and 25 within the Buffalo Valley drainage basin.

T.28N., R.41E., M.D.B.&M.

All of Sections 1 through 24, 26, 27, 28, 33, 34 and 35 and those portions of Sections 25, 30, 31, 32 and 36 within the Buffalo Valley drainage basin.

T.28N., R.42E., M.D.B.&M.

All of Sections 5, 6, 7, 18 and 19 and those portions of Sections 4, 8, 9, 16, 17, 20, 21, 29 and 30 within the Buffalo Valley drainage basin.

All of Section 32 and those portions of Sections 18, 19, 28, 29, 30, 31, 33 and 34 within the Buffalo Valley drainage basin.

T.33N., R.40E., M.D.B.&M.

Those portions of Section 25 and 36 within the Buffalo Valley drainage basin.

T.33N., R.41E., M.D.B.&M.

All of Sections 12, 13, 14, 15, 21 through 29 and 32 through 36 and those portions of Sections 1, 2, 9, 10, 11, 16, 17, 19, 20, 30 and 31 within the Buffalo Valley drainage basin.

T.33N., R.42E., M.D.B.&M.

All of Sections 7, 8, 10, 15 through 22 and 27 through 34 and those portions of Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 9, 11, 14, 23, 24, 25, 35 and 36 within the Buffalo Valley drainage basin.

The designated Buffalo Valley Hydrographic Basin is depicted and defined on Nevada Division of Water Resources, State Engineer's Office maps.

As required under NRS § 534.030, a public hearing in the matter of the designation of the Buffalo Valley Hydrographic Basin was held in Battle Mountain, Nevada, on March 7, 2017. Based on information received at the hearing and other data and information available to the State Engineer, it is determined that this groundwater basin is in need of additional administration under the provisions of NRS Chapter 534.
