TO THE USERS AND CLAIMANTS OF THE WATERS
OF THE SAID SCHELL CREEK STREAM SYSTEM:


You are hereby notified that all evidence, maps, plats, proofs of claims, and related data heretofore taken by or filed with the State Engineer in connection with the determination of the relative rights in and to the waters of Schell Creek and its tributaries in White Pine County will be open for inspection for a period of twenty days, beginning on Monday, July 20, 1936, (Sundays and legal holidays excepted), from 9:00 to 12:00 o'clock A.M., and from 1:00 to 4:30 o'clock P.M. of each day, at the Office of the State Engineer in Carson City, Nevada.

You are also notified that any person claiming any interest in the Schell Creek stream-system and to the use of the water, whether claiming under vested right or under permit from the State Engineer, may object to any finding, part or portion of the Preliminary Order of Determination made by the State Engineer, by filing objections with the State Engineer within thirty days after said evidence and proofs shall have been opened to public inspection. Such objections shall be verified by the affidavit of the objector, his agent or attorney, and shall state, with reasonable certainty, the grounds of objection.
