
ORDER OF REVOCATION OF LICENSE

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING THEREFOR, as hereinabove fully set out, it is hereby ordered, that effective at 12 P.M. June 29th, 1955, well-drilling license number 133, issued by the State Engineer of the State of Nevada, on June 24, 1953, renewed on July 1, 1954, due to expire on July 1, 1955, to Thomas D. de Bruyn, be, and the same is hereby revoked.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that as of the effective date and hour hereof, those wells actually in process of drilling, by licensee, Thomas D. de Bruyn, may be drilled to completion, but that in all other respects license is revoked at the date and hour hereinabove designated.
