

NOTICE OF ORDERS AND PROCEEDINGS

TO DETERMINE WATER RIGHTS

Before the State Engineer of the State of Nevada

IN THE MATTERS OF THE DETERMINATION OF THE RELATIVE RIGHTS IN AND TO THE WATERS OF WRIGHT CANYON CREEK, LITTLE ROCKY CANYON CREEK (ALSO KNOWN AS POLE CANYON CREEK), EAST HORSE CANYON CREEK (ALSO KNOWN AS HORSE CANYON CREEK), AND SACRAMENTO CANYON CREEK AND THEIR TRIBUTARIES IN PERSHING COUNTY, STATE OF NEVADA, (EACH A SEPARATE PROCEEDINGS).


TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

You are hereby notified that on the 20th day of September, 1965, the State Engineer entered orders granting a petition by the City of Lovelock to determine the relative rights in and to the waters of Wright Canyon Creek, Little Rocky Canyon Creek (also known as Pole Canyon Creek), East Horse Canyon Creek (also known as Horse Canyon Creek), and Sacramento Canyon Creek, and their tributaries, located in Pershing County, Nevada.

You are further notified that on the 1st day of November, 1965, the State Engineer will begin proceedings to determine the relative rights in and to the waters of Wright Canyon Creek, Little Rocky Canyon Creek (also known as Pole Canyon Creek), East Horse Canyon Creek (also known as Horse Canyon Creek), and Sacramento Canyon Creek, and their tributaries, located in Pershing County, Nevada. Separate proceedings will be conducted on each of the four sources.

All claimants to rights in and to the waters of said sources are required to make proof of their claims in the manner prescribed by law.
