ORDER DENYINGPETITION

A petition was filed in the office of the State Engineer on January 10, 1969, by the V-B Cattle Company, requesting the State Engineer to determine the relative rights of claimants to the waters of San Juan Creek and Cottonwood Creek and their tributaries.

A field investigation and review of records, made on June 3 and 4, 1969, concerning the said stream systems determined that San Juan Creek and Cottonwood Creek are tributary to the Reese River.

Permits have been issued on these sources under statutory procedure.

The State Engineer, after due investigation and consideration, has determined that the relative rights in and to the waters of San Juan Creek and Cottonwood Creek shall be determined when the waters of Reese River and tributaries are adjudicated.

By virtue of the authority granted under Chapter 533, NRS, the State Engineer enters this Order denying the petition of the V-B Cattle Company.
