



On November 2, 1921, Kate W. Cockrill, a claimant to the use of waters of Pete Hanson Creek and Tributaries, in Eureka County, Nevada, petitioned the State Engineer to determine the relative rights of claimants to the waters of said source.

After due investigation, the State Engineer decided that facts and conditions warrant the initiation of proceedings to effect such determination.

By virtue of the authority granted him in NRS 533.090, the State Engineer enters this Order granting the petition of the claimant named above and will make proper arrangements to proceed with the determination in question.
