The remaining portion of Certificate 2779 (Permit 10409) was issued for 0.1305 c.f.s. or 94.80 acre-feet per year of water from an underground source for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is described as being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 6, T.21S., R.61E., M.D.M.

Nevada Revised Statutes provide that failure for five (5) successive years to use beneficially all or any part of the underground water for the purpose for which such right has been acquired shall work a forfeiture to the use of such water to the extent of such nonuse.

Records, evidence and information on file in the Office of the State Engineer indicate that there has been no beneficial use of water under the subject Certificate and Permit for a period in excess of five (5) successive years.

It is hereby ordered that the remaining portion of Certificate 2779 (Permit 10409) is declared forfeited in its entirety.
