On March 10, 1983 during a field investigation, at which time you were present, representatives of this office observed three dams or obstructions to the flow in the natural stream channels of the upper tributaries of Long Valley Creek which is tributary to the Truckee River. You were advised, at that time, that your construction was in violation of NRS 535.010. These obstructions are located in Sections 16 and 17, T.17N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M. On March 31, 1983 these same obstructions were observed, by a representative of this office, obstructing the stream flow and storing several acre-feet of water.

You are hereby advised that NRS 535.010 prohibits the construction of any obstruction in any stream in the state of Nevada without permission from the State Engineer for such construction. Further, NRS 535.050 provides for removal of any dam or obstruction not in compliance with said statute.

There is no record in the office of the State Engineer indicating compliance with the applicable provisions of NRS relating to the obstructions constructed in Long Valley Creek and its Tributaries within the above described land in Storey County, Nevada. The obstructions are further interfering with the flow of Long Valley Creek and Tributaries.

Therefore, you are hereby ordered to immediately remove said obstructions and restore said natural stream channel and watercourse to its natural condition.
