DESIGNATING AND DESCRIBING THE
HONEY LAKE VALLEY (BASIN NUMBER 97)
GROUND WATER BASIN IN WASHOE COUNTY, NEVADA

The State Engineer finds that conditions warrant the designation of the Honey Lake Valley Ground Water Basin, Washoe County, Nevada, and by this Order designates the following described area of land as a ground water basin coming under the Provisions of NRS Chapter 534 (Conservation and Distribution of Underground Waters).

All of Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 9, 10 and 11 and that portion of Sections 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 and 17 lying within the natural drainage basin of Honey Lake Valley,.

All of Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8 and 11 and that portion of Sections 7, 9, 10, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 and 18 lying within the natural drainage basin of Honey Lake Valley.

That portion of Sections 6 and 7 lying within the natural drainage basin of Honey Lake Valley.
