

ORDER

DESIGNATING AND DESCRIBING THE
STARR VALLEY AREA (BASIN NUMBER 43)
GROUND WATER BASIN IN
ELKO COUNTY, NEVADA

The State Engineer finds that conditions warrant the designation of the Starr Valley Area Ground Water Basin, Elko County, Nevada, and by this Order designates the following described area of land as a ground water basin coming under the provisions of NRS Chapter 534 (Conservation and Distribution of Underground Waters).

T.33N., R.59E., M.D.B.&M.

All of Sections 1, 2 and 12 and that portion of Sections 3, 4, 5, 10, 11, 13 and 14 lying within the natural drainage basin of the Starr Valley Area.

T.33N., R.60E., M.D.B.&M.

That portion of Sections 6 and 7 lying within the natural drainage basin of the Starr Valley Area.

T.34N., R.59E., M.D.B.&M.

All of Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 33, 34, 35 and 36 and that portion of Sections 6, 7, 18, 19, 30, 31 and 32 lying within the natural drainage basin of the Starr Valley Area.

T.34N., R.60E., M.D.B.&M.

All of Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19 and 20 and that portion of Sections 13, 14, 21, 22, 23, 28, 29, 30 and 31 lying within the natural drainage basin of the Starr Valley Area.

That portion of Sections 19, 30 and 31 lying within the natural drainage basin of the Starr Valley Area.

T.38N., R.60E., M.D.B.&M.

That portion of Sections 35 and 36 lying southerly of the Humboldt River within the Starr Valley Area.

T.38N., R.61E., M.D.B.&M.

All of Sections 26, 33 and 34 and that portion of Sections 24, 25, 35 and 36 lying within the natural drainage basin of the Starr Valley Area. Also, that portion of Sections 22, 23, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31 and 32 lying southerly of the Humboldt River.

A public hearing, as required under NRS 534.030, in the matter of the designation of Starr Valley Area Ground Water Basin was held in Elko, Nevada, on June 12, 1985.

The designated Starr Valley Area Basin is depicted and defined on Nevada Division of Water Resources, State Engineer's office Maps.
