O R D E R

EXTENDING THE DESIGNATED AREA OF  
THE EAGLE VALLEY GROUND WATER BASIN (8-104)  
DOUGLAS AND WASHOE COUNTIES, AND CARSON CITY, NEVADA

On February 23, 1972, the State Engineer, by an official Order, designated a described area of land within the Eagle Valley Ground Water Basin in Washoe and Douglas Counties and Carson City, Nevada, coming under the provisions of Chapter 534 NRS.

Under the provisions of Chapter 534 NRS, an Order is hereby made by the State Engineer and entered on the records of the Division of Water Resources, Carson City, Nevada, extending the designated area of the Eagle Valley Ground Water Basin. The boundaries of the Basin are described as follows:

**T.14N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M.**

All of Section 1 and all of that portion of Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12 lying within the natural drainage basin of Eagle Valley.

**T.14N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.**

All of that portion of Sections 5 and 7 lying within the natural drainage basin of Eagle Valley

**T.15N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M.**

All of that portion of Sections 25 and 36 lying within the natural drainage basin of Eagle Valley.

**T.15N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M.**

All of Sections 10, 15, 16, 20, 21, 22, 27, 28, 29, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35 and 36; the S $\frac{1}{2}$  of the N $\frac{1}{2}$ , S $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 25; S $\frac{1}{2}$  N $\frac{1}{2}$ , S $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 26 and all that portion of Sections 3, 4, 8, 9, 17, 18, 19 and 30 lying within the natural drainage basin of Eagle Valley.

**T.15N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.**

Portions of Sections 1 and 11, the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 15, the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 22, the W $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 27, the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 28, the S $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 32 and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 33 lying within the natural drainage basin of Eagle Valley.

**T.16N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M.**

Portions of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 25 and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 34 lying within the natural drainage basin of Eagle Valley.

**T.16N., R.20E., M.D.B. & M.**

All of Sections 27 and 35; the N $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 34 and all of that portion of Sections 15, 16, 21, 22, 23, 25, 26, 28, 29, 30 and 36 lying within the natural drainage basin of Eagle Valley.

A public hearing, as required under NRS 534.030, in the matter of extending the designated area of the Eagle Valley Ground Water Basin was held in Carson City, Nevada, on July 24, 1985.

The designated Eagle Valley Basin is depicted and defined on Nevada Division of Water Resources State Engineer's Office Maps.
