NOTICE OF CURTAILMENT OF WATER APPROPRIATION  
WITHIN THE CARSON VALLEY GROUND WATER BASIN (8-105)  
DOUGLAS COUNTY, NEVADA

WHEREAS, the State Engineer has designated the Carson Valley Ground Water Basin as provided under NRS 534.010 to NRS 534.190, inclusive, by Order 684.

WHEREAS, NRS 534.120 provides that within an area that has been designated by the State Engineer where, in his judgment, the ground water basin is being depleted the State Engineer, in his administrative capacity, is empowered to make such rules, regulations and orders as are deemed essential for the welfare of the area involved.

After consultation with Douglas County, the State Health Department and the Division of Environmental Protection, the State Engineer finds that conditions warrant the curtailment of future appropriation within the following described areas within the Carson Valley Ground Water Basin:

**T.13N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.**

The NW $\frac{1}{4}$  and the W $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 1; all of Sections 2, 3 and 4; the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  and the E $\frac{1}{2}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 10; the N $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 11 and the W $\frac{1}{2}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 12 lying within the natural drainage basin of Carson Valley.

**T.14N., R.20E., M.D.B.&M.**

The SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and the S $\frac{1}{2}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 20; the S $\frac{1}{2}$  and the S $\frac{1}{2}$  of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 21; the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 22; the E $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 29; all of Sections 26, 27, 28, 33, 34 and 35; the E $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 32 and the W $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 36 lying within the natural drainage basin of Carson Valley.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: Any applications to appropriate additional water or move existing rights outside the described area to a point of diversion within the area will be denied.

However, the State Engineer will continue to consider applications for minimal appropriations of water for preferred uses as authorized under NRS 534.120 where public benefit and interest can be demonstrated.
