Pursuant to complaint submitted to the State Engineer by the Bureau of Land Management, U.S. Department of Interior, concerning the alleged unauthorized use of Hackberry Spring located within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 1, T.12S., R.67E., M.D.B.&M., representatives of this office made a field investigation on November 20, 1985. It was determined at said field investigation that water from Hackberry Spring was in fact being used for mining and domestic purposes without a permit or valid claim of vested right.

You are hereby advised that NRS 533.460 prohibits the unauthorized use of water to which another person is entitled or the wilful waste of water to the detriment of another, shall be a misdemeanor and the possession or use of such water without legal right shall be prima facie evidence of the guilt of the person using or diverting it.

There is no record in the office of the State Engineer indicating compliance with applicable provisions of NRS relating to your use of Hackberry Spring.

THEREFORE, you are hereby ordered to immediately cease the use of said waters and further to return the spring to its natural condition.
