Applications 46010 and 46011 were filed on August 10, 1982, for permission to appropriate the public waters of the State of Nevada from an underground source within the Colorado River Valley Ground Water Basin.

Permits were granted under the provisions of NRS 534.120 and issued subject to revocation when water was available from a water district or municipality engaged in furnishing water.

Water is now available to the places of use described therein from the Big Bend Water District and the District is, in fact, presently providing water service.

Permit 46010 located within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 28, T.32S., R.66E., M.D.B.&M., and Permit 46011 located within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 28, T.32S., R.66E., M.D.B.&M., were revoked on June 27, 1985 by Order No. 861 issued by the State Engineer. The wells drilled under Permits 46010 and 46011 are ordered plugged and sealed within 60 days of the date of this order in accordance with the Regulations for Drilling Wells.
