You are a water user on the Little Humboldt River Stream System and its tributaries.

This water system was adjudicated under Case No. 3157 in the Sixth Judicial District Court of the State of Nevada in and for the County of Humboldt. The adjudication determined all the relative rights of all claimants and appropriators of the waters of the Little Humboldt River System.


The rights of all users were set out in the "Little Humboldt River Adjudication", sometimes referred to as the "Carville Decree".

On page 74 of the Carville Decree in the fourth full paragraph, the Court ordered, adjudged and decreed that headgates and measuring devices **"...shall be installed and maintained by or at the expense of each of the water users for proper measurement of his water in the main ditches"**. (Emphasis added.)

To insure that you as a water user of the Little Humboldt River System get your decreed water, you are hereby ordered as follows:

1. To install a substantial headgate as designated by the State Engineer. This headgate must be adequate to enable regulation of water to an open or closed position and must be able to be secured and locked;
2. To install a measuring device or weir as designated by the State Engineer. This measuring device must be adequate to measure water easily in order to facilitate water distribution; and
3. To have the above described headgate and weir installed and in operable condition before the start of the irrigation season of 1987.

The Decree sets the irrigation season on the Little Humboldt River from April 1st, continuing for 180 days thereafter.
