A field inspection made by the State Engineer's office on August 28, 1984, revealed that the well drilled in the E 1/2, NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 3, T.23S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., located at Sunset Road and Maryland Parkway at an address commonly known as 1001 East Sunset Road, Las Vegas, Nevada, has been abandoned; and, due to its location in a drainage gully, presents a potential source of contamination to the ground water aquifer, which is a source of public water supply for the Las Vegas metropolitan area.

Pursuant to the authority set forth in Chapters 534 and 445 of the Nevada Revised Statutes, the State Engineer and the Administrator of the Division of Environmental Protection, Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, State of Nevada, sign and conclude that the above described abandoned well is a potential source of contamination to the public water supply.

THEREFORE, you are hereby ordered, on the respective authority granted under Chapters 534 and 445 of the Nevada Revised Statutes, to immediately perform the following, which is essential to safeguard life and property and protect the public interest and welfare:

1. You will plug said well in accordance with Part 14 (Plugging Wells) of the State Engineer's "Regulations for Drilling Water Wells" as set forth in Chapter 534 of the Nevada Administrative Code;
2. You will notify the Southern Nevada Branch Office of the Division of Water Resources, 1515 East Tropicana Avenue, Suite No. 375, Las Vegas, Nevada 89119, (702) 486-7165, as to the exact time the plugging operation will commence;
3. You will provide the undersigned with a written report of compliance as required by Regulation 14.03 (NAC 534.420) (5).
