DESIGNATING AND DESCRIBING THE JEAN LAKE VALLEY
GROUND WATER BASIN WITHIN CLARK COUNTY, NEVADA

The State Engineer finds that conditions warrant the designation of the Jean Lake Valley Ground Water Basin, Clark County, Nevada, and by this order designates the following described area of land as a ground water basin coming under the provisions of NRS Chapter 534 (Conservation and Distribution of Underground Water).

T.23S., R.59E.

That portion of Sections 35 and 36 lying within the Natural Drainage Basin of Jean Lake Valley.

T.23S., R.60E.

That portion of Section 31 lying within the natural drainage basin of Jean Lake Valley.

T.24S., R.59E.

All of Section 1 and that portion of Sections 2, 11, 12, 13, 24, 25 and 36 lying within the natural drainage basin of Jean Lake Valley.

T.24S., R.60E.

All of Sections 7, 8, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 27, 28, 29, 30, 32, 33, 34 and 35 and that portion of Sections 4, 5, 6, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 24, 25, 26 and 36 lying within the natural drainage basin of Jean Lake Valley.

T.24S., R.61E.

That portion of Sections 18 and 19 lying within the natural drainage basin of Jean Lake Valley.

T.25S., R.60E.

All of Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 34, 35 and 36 and that portion of Sections 1, 6, 7, 18, 19, 29, 32 and 33 lying within the natural drainage basin of Jean Lake Valley.

T.25S., R.61E.

All of Sections 18, 19, 29, 30 and 31 and that portion of Sections 6, 7, 8, 16, 17, 20, 21, 28, 32 and 33 lying within the natural drainage basin of Jean Lake Valley.

T.26S., R.60E.

All of Sections 1, 2, 3, 11, 12, 13, 14, 23, 24, 25 and 36 and that portion of Sections 4, 5, 9, 10, 15, 22, 26, 27 and 35 lying within the natural drainage basin of Jean Lake Valley.

T.26S., R.61E.

All of Sections 5, 6, 7, 8, 17, 18, 19, 30 and 31 and that portion of Sections 4, 9, 16, 20, 21, 29 and 32 lying within the natural drainage basin of Jean Lake Valley.

T.27S., R.60E.

That portion of Sections 1 and 2 lying within the natural drainage basin of Jean Lake Valley.

T.27S., R.61E.

That portion of Sections 4, 5, 6 and 7 lying within the natural drainage basin of Jean Lake Valley.
