
(20) Remarks: This well was originally drilled in the early 1890's by Cradlebaugh. (see Affidavit attached as Exhibit "A"). Water was used on the ranch property which consisted of Lots 1 and 2 of NW 1/4, Section 30; Lots 1 and 2 of SW 1/4, Section 30; N 1/2 of Lots 1 and 2 of NW 1/4 Section 31; all in T.14N., R.20E. Well is described as follows:

4" casing with hose bibs and shut off valve. Total depth of the well is unknown. Three other wells are located on the property. They were drilled between 1915-1918. By the Ambrosetti Family as per the affidavit. Water from this well was used to provide irrigation water to lawn, garden and areas not served by Carson River or other sources. Water was also used for stock. Claim is made on the basis of available information. Additional records will be filed pending further research of the subject well.

The undersigned, being first duly sworn, deposes and says that the facts relative to the appropriation of water by Theodore H. Stokes are full and correct to the best of his knowledge and belief. Deponent is acting as Agent for the Claimant.
