

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATION NO. 52
FILED BY GEORGE L. JORDAN TO APPROPRIATE
WATER FROM A SPRING IN NYE COUNTY, NEVADA. }

R U L I N G

General:

Application No. 52 was filed on March 5, 1966 by George L. Jordan to appropriate all the flow of a spring located $3\frac{1}{2}$ miles west of south from Manhattan, Nevada on unsurveyed ground. The proposed manner of use was for domestic purposes. The proposed place of use was in Manhattan.

A letter, sent by certified mail, dated July 26, 1968 was mailed to the applicant at the best available address, requesting additional information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application. This letter was returned, stamped "unknown", by the Post Office Department. It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office advised of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application No. 52 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest failed to submit the requested information and the granting of a permit under this application, without the requested information, would be detrimental to the public welfare.
