R U L I N G

Application 85 was filed April 17, 1966, by Ciras Mining Company for permission to appropriate 5.0 c.f.s. of water from Black Springs for mining and milling purposes. The proposed point of diversion is described as being within the NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 6, T.3N., R.50E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use is not described.

A letter dated July 26, 1968, was forwarded by certified mail to the best available address for the applicant requesting additional information necessary before a Permit could be issued under this application. This letter was returned stamped: "Unclaimed" by the Post Office Department. It is the responsibility of the applicant or their successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application 85 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicants or their successors in interest failed to submit the requested information and the approval of this application without said information would be detrimental to the public welfare.
